#### What is a résumé?

A résumé (also spelled resume) is a brief document that summarizes your education, employment history, and experiences that are relevant to your qualifications for a particular job for which you are applying. The purpose of a résumé (along with your cover letter) is to get an interview. Research has shown that it takes an average of ten (10) interviews to receive one

(1) job offer, so your résumé needs to be persuasive and perfect. Given this, your résumé must be **user-centered and persuasive**.

The general purpose résumé usually contains four sections:

- Contact
- Education
- Experience
- Honors, activities, and outreach

#### WRITING THE CONTACT SECTION OF YOUR RÉSUMÉ

This section of your résumé is definitely the easiest to write, but you do have a few options for design and content.

What is a contact information section?

Unlike other sections of your résumé, this section does not have a special heading like "Contact Information." Instead it simply lists the information below at the top of the page:

- Your full name
- Your e-mail address
- Your permanent address
- Your local or campus address (if applicable)
- Your phone number(s)
- Your web address/URL
- Your fax number, etc.

Of course, as with the rest of your résumé, you'll want to double-check that all the information you include is current and accurate. Mistyping your phone number could easily cost you an interview! Also, if you list an e-mail address, be sure to check your e-mail regularly or you may miss an important message.

If you live on campus, you should provide your campus address. But you may also want to provide your home address.

# GUEST LECTURE ON COMMUNICATION SKILL AND BUSINESS <u>ETIQUETTES</u>

Mr. Ankit Mehta addressed on the topic. He emphasized on essential communication skills for a successful career. The session highlighted on the image, communication, competence, demeanor in the profession. Students and faculty members of the college participated in the session.

Firstly, Chairman Mr. Vijay Agarwal, along with Mr. P.K. Jain, Dr. Manish Portal welcome the guest, then Mr. Vijay Agarwal said few words and Mr. P.K. Jain also express his views on communication skills.

This module focuses on working in groups and teams. Good manners or etiquette is an underlying theme to starting interaction on the right foot. While some of the things discussed in this section may seem like common knowledge or common sense, it can be helpful to be reminded of basic manners. Additionally, there are several important reminders or lessons about working with others and attending corporate events.

#### Attire

At a distance, initial impressions begin with attire. Are you dressed appropriately for this workplace? To "dress up" changes meaning from a Saturday night club to a place of worship to the workplace. Absent a uniform or direct corporate attire policy, look at what your boss and your boss's boss wear in the workplace. Try to dress like those people as long as it's appropriate for the job you actually do. However, do not overdo it in a manner that causes you not to fit in. If everyone at your workplace wears slacks and dress shirts, don't wear a three-piece suit!

One bit of shared wisdom is to dress like the employee you want to be with your next promotion. There are times where you may be asked to attend an event away from the usual workplace. It may even be a bit social (such as taking a customer out for a meal). It is better to ask others about appropriate attire than to show up incorrectly dressed. This skill works in individual situations and particularly well when in a group. Think of your clothing as showing respect to the other person or persons.

Taking this forward, he explained about protocol, to shore up the professional relationships and networking skills. Planning, though crucial, should not eat up months or years during the starting phase. He suggested that recessions are great times to start new ventures, as hiring talent becomes easier during such phases. He also discussed scaling up, recruiting and its associated challenges. According to him, beautiful things can happen when change happens. He then took the session forward by sharing his insights on general guidelines for manners and behavior in the corporate sector. Also to introduce students to business etiquette and grooming and to familiarize them with formal set up of dress code in a workplace. He conveyed that, every culture has its own different set of manners, and a lot of manners are common across cultures which is important to follow them.
